

Request for Revision to Add High School Grades

Resolution

I recommend that the Board of Trustees adopt the following resolution:

Whereas the True North Troy Preparatory Charter School Board of Trustees (the “Board”), wishes to provide a high school option for its current elementary and middle school students; now therefore be it

Resolved that the Board requests to add high school grades to True North Troy Preparatory Charter School (“Troy Prep”) beginning with 9th grade in the 2017-18 school year and 9th and 10th grade in the 2018-19 school year; and also be it

Resolved that the Board authorizes Troy Prep, in conjunction with Uncommon Schools, to complete and submit to the SUNY Board of Trustees on its behalf a request to revise the Troy Prep charter as outlined above.

Background

To ensure high quality high school options for students attending Troy Prep, the Troy Prep Board of Trustees wishes to expand its grades served to include a high school program. The Troy Prep High School would open in the fall of 2017. In its first year, the school would admit 9th grade students who formerly attended Troy Prep Middle School. The high school program would expand by one grade each year, ultimately serving grades 9-12.
